| 1 | DOMAINE LES ROUCAS Chardonnay, Vin de Pays d'Oc (Fra)
Delicious "anytime drinking" chardonnay from the Languedoc; light, crisp, refreshing with a nice pale yellow colour with green glints; very move'ish! 13%abv | | | |
| 2 | VINA LOS BOLDOS Sauvignon Blanc, Alta Cachapoal Valley (Chi)
Pale lemon with green lights. On the nose are notes of green apple, passion fruit, caramelised lemons and white stone fruits. On the palate the wine is scintillatingly fresh, with fine supporting acidity, good concentration and great depth of fruit flavours. The finish is long and complex. 13.5%abv | £4.40 | £5.80 | £16.50 |
| 3 | KLIPPENKOP ESTATE Chenin Blanc, Coastal Region (SA)
This white wine has lovely pineapple and ripe fruity melon flavours on the nose, following through to a limy, full middle-palate and finishing in crisp freshness. 12.7%abv. Medium-dry | £4.40 | £5.80 | £16.50 |
| 4 | PINOT GRIGIO del Veneto, Ca del Bianco, Botter (Ita)
Very pale lemon coloured, the nose shows spicy pears and preserved lemon. The palate is mouth wateringly refreshing, with apple and pear flavours, a rounded texture and a dry, crisp finish which develops spicy notes. 12%abv | £4.60 | £5.90 | £17.00 |
| 5 | THE HOLY SNAIL Sauvignon Blanc, Loire Valley (Fra)
Award-winning wine from master-winemaker, Thierry Delaunay. Classic old-world sauvignon that is a half-way house from a Sancerre to a Kiwi, fruit-driven style; lovely! 12.5%abv | £4.60 | £5.90 | £17.00 |

| 7 | DOMAINE LES ROUCAS Merlot, Vin de Pays d'Oc (Fra)
From the Languedoc region comes this delightful red, showing wonderful fruit flavours of red fruits, especially cherries, and hints of spice. Perfectly ripe fruit produces a round, soft wine of great character. 13%abv | £4.30 | £5.70 | £16.00 |
| 8 | CHATEAU JAUMARD, AC Bordeaux (Cabernet & Merlot) | £4.40 | £5.80 | £16.50 |
| 8B | Magnum 150cl (Fra)
Well-structured Bordeaux with good, upfront fruit and a hint of juicy spice. Medium bodied, smooth and well-balanced, with a herbaceous note on the finish. Brilliant example of the fabulous 09 vintage. Also, enjoy in magnum! 13%abv | | | Magnum £33.00 |

9	KLIPPENKOP ESTATE Pinotage, Coastal Region (SA) The Klippenkop wines are produced by the famous Robertson winery. Delicious flavours of ripe strawberries, bananas, juicy plums and rich red cherries, are well-integrated with notes of oak, followed by a wonderfully smooth finish. 13.5%abv	£4.60	£5.90	£17.00
10	ALDRIDGE ESTATE, "Rams Head" Shiraz & Cabernet (Aus) Showing ripe berry fruit with sweet oak aromas on the nose. Ripe plum and raspberry fruit showing great depth and length of flavour. Lightly toasted French Oak and soft tannins finish the long palate. 13.5%abv	£4.60	£5.90	£17.00

11	ALDRIDGE ESTATE, "Twyndham" Chardonnay (Aus) Green apple and pear aromas with upfront tropical fruit dominating the palate with some lingering white peach flavours. The mouth feel is crisp and fresh, with a lingering finish. 13%abv			£18.50
12	DOMAINE DE PETIT ROUBIÉ Viognier, officially certified organic winery (Fra) Pale gold in colour, with an intense bouquet of wild flowers (violets) and stone fruits (mangoes and apricots). Deliciously rich and fruity on the palate, with fine balancing acidity. As it evolves it gives off aromas and flavours of musk and spice cake, finishing on a long, rich, satisfyingly fruity note. 13%abv			£19.50
13	RIBBONWOOD ESTATE Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc (NZ) Nose reminiscent of grapefruit, dried thyme, ripe tropical fruit and currant. Classic passion fruit and grapefruit flavours, smartened up with currant, capsicum and hints of mineral. Mouth-watering acidity makes you want to take another sip. Close your eyes and imagine how cool, clear water rushing over fist sized stones on its way to the sea would taste. 13%abv			£19.50
14	CHATEAU PETIT ROUBIÉ Picpoul de Pinet, officially certified organic winery (Fra) A golden coloured white wine with brilliant pearly green reflections. The complex nose combines the dominant aroma of flowers with the scent of white peach and the exotic flavour of pineapples. Initially round and full the taste rapidly changes to lively. The nicely balanced acid-alcohol content brings out the fruity aromas. The long and full after-taste leaves suggestions of citrus and hard fruit; fish & seafood perfect. 12.5%abv			£21.50
15	VAL DO SOSEGO Albariño, Rias Baixas (Spa) Spain's answer to a crisp, dry Chablis in style. Lemon in colour with greenish highlights. High intensity on the nose, with the characteristic aromas of the Albariño grape. This is a dry, elegant example, with broad flavours, fine balance and a lingering, mouth-watering finish. It is truly excellent with fish and seafood. 12.5%abv			£25.00
16	SAINT-VERAN "Tirage Précoce" (unoaked), Domaine Corsin (Fra) All stainless steel fermentation preserves the crisp apple freshness of this wine. Good weight and body, lovely underlying acidity and a persistent, long finish; a pure expression of Mâconnais Chardonnay. An excellent value 'everyday' Chardonnay.			£29.50

ROSÉ WINE - By the bottle

- 17 **COTES DE PROVENCE ROSÉ, "Melopée de Gavoty" (Fra)** £21.50
Deceptively pale, the nose is full of crushed summer fruits, whilst the palate is a mouth watering blend of strawberries and redcurrants (60% Syrah, 40% Cabernet Sauvignon), allied to a creamy texture, considerable weight and a long crisp finish. "Sat on the terrace outside Domaine Gavoty, having a lunch of grilled sardines and ratatouille washed down with an ice cold glass of rosé, it was difficult to imagine a more beautiful place to be..." Just dreaming! 13.5%abv

RED WINES - By the bottle

- 18 **MARQUES DE REINOSA Rioja Tinto 2010 (Spa)** £19.00
Elegant and soft, with classic flavours of plum, strawberries, vanilla and spice. This is a lighter style Rioja that makes perfect lunchtime (and plainer meat dishes) drinking; elegant and medium weight. 13.5%abv
- 19 **DOMAINE DE PETIT ROUBIÉ Syrah, officially certified organic winery (Fra)** £19.50
This deep ruby coloured powerful wine is remarkably delicate. It offers a complex nose, combining red fruit and typical spices. In the mouth it is supple, its tannins, harmonious and melting are ever present. The aromas are in keeping with this noble grape. 13%abv
- 20 **COTES DU RHONE VILLAGES "Cairanne", Domaine de la Présidente (Fra)** £21.50
A deep ruby in colour with purple glints, the bouquet is powerful and distinctive. On the palate the wine is well-balanced and fruity with a long and exquisite finish. An ideal partner for red meats and game. 13.5%abv
- 21 **RIBBONWOOD ESTATE Marlborough Pinot Noir (NZ)** £25.00
Welcoming nose with raspberry, Kirsch and cranberry scents. Lush, rounded palate with dark and summer fruit compote flavours. Charming, with good intensity and tannin structure. Some gently supporting oak and dark chocolate flavours add interest. Excellent with duck or lamb dishes. Ribbonwood is a native tree, tall and strong in character, with wonderfully fragrant spring blossom - symbolism that sums up these extraordinary wines perfectly. 13.5%abv
- 22 **LES BRULIERES DE BEUCHEVELLE 2006, Château Beychevelle, Cru Bourgeois Bordeaux (Fra)** £39.50
Aged and bottled at Château Beychevelle from grapes grown in vineyards to the south of St. Julien in the Haut-Médoc. Medium to full-bodied in style with attractive, rich, plummy berried fruit aromas as well as excellent balance, structure and length. Beychevelle, being situated in the most southern part of the appellation, is often characterised by its finesse and elegance (Margaux in style) in contrast to its more muscular northern neighbours (close to Pauillac).
