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| 1 | WOOLLOOMOOLOO Chardonnay, South East Australia (Aus)
<i>Light straw in colour, Woolloomooloo Chardonnay displays an enticing nose of peach, citrus and lemon aromas. The tropical fruit flavours and luscious mouth feel mid-palate complement each other to deliver a deliciously rounded wine with a crisp and clean finish balanced nicely by gentle acidity.</i> | £4.80 | £6.00 | £17.50 |
| 2 | PINOT GRIGIO del Veneto, "Amanti", IGT (Ita)
<i>Pinot Grigio from Northern Italy is one of the most popular styles of dry white wine on the market. With its floral character, this wine is crisp, refreshing and unoaked, making it perfect for drinking before or during any meal.</i> | £4.90 | £6.30 | £18.00 |
| 3 | MARCEL MARTIN Sauvignon Blanc, Loire Valley (Fra)
<i>A lovely fresh Sauvignon from the Loire Valley. Glass filling aromas of gooseberry and grapefruit notes. Fresh and vibrant with nicely integrated citrus and stone fruits flavours. Some complexity and a deliciously long finish.</i> | £5.00 | £6.50 | £18.50 |
| 4 | DOMAINE LA SERRE, Picpoul de Pinet, Languedoc (Fra)
<i>This is a lovely wine for all seasons and occasions. Known as the "Chablis of the South", the wines of Picpoul de Pinet are crisp and refreshing. Fruity-dry on the palate with notes of peach, melon and grapefruit with zesty acidity and an intense minerality, giving a long, refreshing finish.</i> | £5.90 | £7.50 | £21.50 |

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| 5 | WHITE ZINFANDEL Rosé, "Compass Point", California (U.S.A) <i>V fruity!</i>
<i>Pure fruit cocktail start to finish with an amazing twang of fresh summer fruits – strawberries/citrus – with a lovely bright pink colour. A very cheerful and fruity rosé, to charm any dish and quite lovely on its own. Also, pudding perfect! 10.5% abv</i> | £4.80 | £6.00 | £17.50 |
| 6 | PINOT GRIGIO Blush Rosé, Amanti, Veneto IGT (Ita)
<i>Amanti comes from the Veneto region in the north easterly part of Italy. The area produces lovely, delicate wines and this rosé is a classic example. Plenty of summer fruits and lively acidity make this enjoyable on any occasion. 12% abv</i> | £5.00 | £6.50 | £18.50 |

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| 7 | WOOLLOOMOOLOO Shiraz, South East Australia (Aus)
<i>Opaque and ruby red in colour, Woolloomooloo Shiraz displays a nose of ripe berry fruits with a touch of mint. Smooth and rich on the palate with spicy flavours of luscious dark berry fruits, the balanced soft-tannins help deliver a tremendously concentrated finish.</i> | £4.80 | £6.00 | £17.50 |
| 8 | PARLEZ VOUS Malbec, South West France (Fra)
<i>This extremely well-priced Malbec from the sunny south of France is a revelation! Made in a modern, fruity style, it could easily be mistaken for an Argentinian Malbec from Mendoza. A very attractive and fruit-forward wine with an expressive blackberry fruit and crunchy red berry characters.</i> | £5.00 | £6.50 | £18.50 |
| 9 | SANTA DIGNA Merlot, Miguel Torres, Central Valley, (Chi) – Free Trade
<i>In 1979 the Torres family from Spain were the first foreign company to pioneer quality Chilean wines. Aged for 6 months in American oak this produces a soft rounded richly textured wine with ripe plum flavours and a discreet hint of vanilla. Food Match: Roast and grilled meats including game. An excellent red wine for any occasion.</i> | £5.30 | £6.80 | £19.50 |
| 10 | BANDA AZUL, Rioja Tinto, Paternina (Spa)
<i>It is only because a certain person - very closely associated with The Woolpack - really loves this wine, which is why it is placed in the "By The Glass" section, and way below its real value! This Crianza is a blend of 75% Tempranillo, 25% Garnacha aged 12 months in American oak barrels. Lively aromas of spicy black cherry, smooth and warming with plenty of red berry fruit flavours, vanilla and notes of exotic spices. Classic Rioja style with vibrant fruit and integrated new oak. IWSC Silver Medal.</i> | £5.90 | £7.50 | £21.50 |

WHITE WINES - By the bottle

- 11 RIBBONWOOD ESTATE Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc (NZ) £24.50
Nose reminiscent of grapefruit, dried thyme, ripe tropical fruit and currant. Classic passion fruit and grapefruit flavours, smartened up with currant, capsicum and hints of mineral. Fantastic Kiwi Sauvignon without the 'overblown fruit salad factor' we so often find.
- 12 MACON LUGNY, 'Les Genièvres', Louis Latour (Fra) £29.50
The vineyard of 'Les Genièvres' is one of the best of the Mâcon-Lugny Appellation. A lovely white Burgundy with a light golden pale robe and greenish highlights. Pure, fresh aromas and peach, lemon and apple flavours with attractive creamy notes. Nicely rounded on the palate with ripe stone fruits and a twist of lemon on the finish. Good freshness and length. This single vineyard wine comes from one of the best villages in the Maconnais.
- 13 SANCERRE, "Domaine de la Tonnellerie" (Fra) £31.95
Delicious, very easy drinking and unpretentious Sancerre; it is dry with a lovely rich fruity Sauvignon bouquet that is reminiscent of ripe citrus and gooseberries. Most important, we keep this charming and highly approachable white wine to a sensible price point.

RED WINES - By the bottle

- 14 FLEURIE, "Caves de Fleurie", Cru Beaujolais, Burgundy (Fra) £24.50
This modern style (fruit driven) wine is bursting with ripe red berry fruit flavours. It is soft and fresh, with delicate light tannins. Perfect lunchtime/summer red wine drinking, made from the Gamay grape. Arguably the most feminine, most attractive of all the Crus Beaujolais wines. The wine is made using carbonic maceration method, traditional in the Beaujolais region. 13% abv Vegetarian – Yes, Vegan – Yes.
- 15 RIBBONWOOD ESTATE Marlborough Pinot Noir (NZ) £31.95
Welcoming nose with raspberry, kirsch and cranberry scents. Lush, rounded palate with dark and summer fruit compote flavours. Charming, with good intensity and tannin structure. Some gently supporting oak and dark chocolate flavours add interest. Excellent with duck or lamb dishes. Ribbonwood is a native tree, tall and strong in character, with wonderfully fragrant spring blossom - symbolism that sums up these extraordinary wines perfectly.
- 16 Château BEAUMONT, "Cru Bourgeois" Haut-Medoc, Bordeaux (Fra) £39.50
Beaumont is managed and vinified exactly as a Cru Classé winery. This is a very fine claret indeed. Elegant, full flavoured and well balanced, with a lovely colour, smooth subtle bouquet and complex finish.
- 17 Château TALBOT 2006, 4ème Cru Classé, St Julien, Bordeaux (Fra) £75.00
*The 2006 exhibits sweet, olive-tinged black cherry and currant fruit, soft tannin, a heady attack, good freshness and acidity, and a lush, fleshy finish. It will drink beautifully in 4-6 years, and last for two decades". 89-91 points. Robert Parker, The Wine Advocate. **Only a few bottles left.***

SPARKLING, CHAMPAGNE & PORT

- 18 AMORI Prosecco, Extra Dry NV, Veneto, Italy £23.00
Winemakers Bruno Cecchetto and Mattia Giacomelli allow the wine to spend some time in contact with its lees in order to add softness and body. Unusual for a prosecco. The result is a delightful wine with fresh apple, pear and apricot aromas and floral notes. Crisp and elegant with fine bubbles, it is perfect served as an aperitif.
- 19 **Baby Bottle 20cl** 'Borgo San Leo' NV Brut **Baby Bottle** £7.50
- 20 CHAMPAGNE JOSEPH PERRIER Brut NV, 'Cuvée Royale' £49.00
The 'Cuvée Royale' Brut is named because it was supplied to their late majesties Queen Victoria and King Edward VII. It is made up of near equal proportions of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier, to give structure and balance.
- 21 **Half Bottle 37.5cl** **Half Bottle** £24.50
- 22 OFFLEY Late Bottled Vintage Port £3.50 **50ml Glass** £39.50
Elegant and complex aromas of full, ripe, red-black fruit. This Late Bottled Vintage Port is a perfect match for cheeses, and puddings.
